What is the main energy source in Gabon?

It also ranks as the 3rd largest oil producer in sub-Saharan Africa; following Nigeria & Angola . The country's two main energy sources are fossil-fuels and hydropower. 51.7% of Gabon's total produced electricity in 2015 were generated from hydro,and 48.2% were from fossil fuels .

How much electricity does Gabon produce?

Gabon's total electricity production in 2015 was 199 kilotonneof oil equivalent (ktoe),with 51.7% produced from hydropower sources and 48.2% from fossil fuels. The country's final consumption of electricity was 169 ktoe.

Who controls the oil industry in Gabon?

The government of Gaboncontrols all petroleum and mineral rights within the state. In 2011 a presidential decree created the Gabon Oil Company (GOC). This new entity works in partnership with international companies operating in Gabon and operates two fields: Obangue and Remboue.

Are stand-alone solar systems a viable solution for remote communities in Gabon?

Yet,as mentioned earlier,the country is heavily forested,which stands in the way of connecting remote communities to the country's main grid . Therefore,with such solar conditions,stand-alone solar systems would be the ideal solutionfor power generation for these communities in Gabon .

How much energy does Gabon need in 2021?

Gabon CO<sub>2</sub> Fuel Combustion/CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions. In its NDC (2016), Gabon set the commitment to reduce its GHG emissions by at least 50% in 2025 as compared to a BAU scenario, including LULUCF (Land Use, Land-Use Change and Forestry), which accounts for more than 60% of direct emissions, but excluding carbon stocks in forests (i.e. sinks).

Energy in Gabon comes from two main sources, fossil-fuels and hydroelectricity. Gabon also relies heavily on oil for its export revenues, exporting both crude oil and petroleum. In terms its oil reserves, the country is one of the richest in sub-Saharan Africa, ranking 5th after Nigeria, Angola, Sudan, South Sudan, and Uganda. [1]
