Vince Smith, head of energy solutions at Guernsey Electricity Under Guernsey's Environmental Sustainability Strategy, the island has a target of installing up to 20MW of community solar power by 2050.

A plan for Guernsey's future energy needs has been delayed again. The Committee for Environment and Infrastructure (E& I) had originally planned to publish the plan in December 2022.

A typical Guernsey home has at least one roof that faces east, south or west, or a flat roof that may be open to all the sun's orientations. From a few panels to four panels or more and typically 6 to 10 panels, you can maximise your generation by maximising your roof spaces.

The import cable alone does not meet the islands electricity needs when energy demand is at its greatest. The GJ1 cable can provide 100% of Guernsey's energy needs in summer and around 75% in winter, so the power station is still required as both a top-up for the winter peak periods and as a back-up when the GJ1 interconnector requires to be switched off for maintenance.
