

How is cargo transported in Kazakhstan?

In terms of cargo load, railways transport is the most used mode of transport in Kazakhstan, followed by automobile and pipelines. In real terms, cargo volume via other modes of transport remains insignificant. Rivers of Kazakhstan have limited capacity for cargo transportation, unlike those from North America or Europe.

Who is the biggest foreign investor in Kazakhstan?

The EU is also the biggest foreign investor in Kazakhstan, providing EUR54.8 billion of total foreign direct investment (FDI) stock in 2022: a 5.5% increase compared to 2021. In 2023, the EU's trade in goods with Kazakhstan totalled EUR42.4 billion, a 5.6% increase on 2022.

Does Kazakhstan invest in transport & logistics?

Kazakhstan has invested \$35bn in transport and logistics over the past 15 years. Share of transport and logistics in Kazakhstan's GDP is forecast to grow from 6.2% in 2022 to 9% by 2025. Although the cargo load has stabilised in recent years, it has grown significantly over the last decade.

Who is Kazakhstan's biggest trading partner?

The EU is Kazakhstan's biggest overall trading partner, as the destination for 37% of total Kazakh exports and representing 27.9% of its total trade in 2023. The EU is also the biggest foreign investor in Kazakhstan, providing EUR54.8 billion of total foreign direct investment (FDI) stock in 2022: a 5.5% increase compared to 2021.

What are EU trade relations with Kazakhstan?

EU trade relations with Kazakhstan. Facts, figures and latest developments. The Enhanced Partnership and Cooperation Agreement (EPCA), which entered into force on 1 March 2020, governs trade and economic relations between the European Union and Kazakhstan. Kazakhstan is the first Central Asian partner to have concluded an EPCA with the EU.

What are EU exports to Kazakhstan?

EU exports to Kazakhstan are more diverse: for example, machinery and transport equipment (52.9% of total EU exports in 2023), chemical products (16.1%), optical products (5.1%), metals (4%), plastics (3.9%), and textiles (3.2%). EU services exports to Kazakhstan stood at EUR2.1 billion in 2022, compared to EUR1.5 billion in 2021.
