Does Moldova need energy?

Moldova is almost totally dependent on fossil fuel and electricity imports, with natural gas serving most of its energy needs. The government plans to diversify the energy mix with renewables such as wind and solar.

What is Moldova's energy policy?

Moldova's energy policy focuses on improving integration in regional markets, strengthening energy security, improving compliance with EU directives, increasing electricity generation capacity and promoting energy efficiency and renewable energy.

Is Moldova a member of the Energy Community?

Moldova has been a member of the Energy Community since 2010 and signed an Association Agreement with the European Union on 27 June 2014. It therefore had until December 2017 to make its legislation conform to the EU *acquis communautaire*, which

How does Moldova share energy data?

Moldova shares energy data through five annual International Energy Agency (IEA)/Eurostat/UN Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) joint questionnaires.

What should Moldova do about electricity integration?

Moldova should accelerate the transposition and implementation of the Electricity Integration Package, prioritizing short-term electricity markets and their integration. The certification of Vestmoldtransgaz should be finalized, followed by the removal of barriers to create a genuine free gas market.

What was Moldova's primary energy supply in 2018?

Primary energy supply in 2018 was about half natural gas, a quarter oil and solid biomass one-fifth. Renewable energy has expanded rapidly and Moldova is seeking to diversify sources of energy and cease purchasing from Russia.

Moldova imports all of its supplies of petroleum, coal, and natural gas; until 2022, imports came largely from Russia.. Moldova was an observer to the treaty establishing the Energy Community from the outset (2006). Following its interest in full membership, the European Commission was mandated to carry out accession negotiations with Moldova in 2007.

In 2022, Moldova experienced one of its worst energy crises because of the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Through international cooperation, Moldova seeks to implement its energy strategy by 2030 for energy independence, security, ...
