How many solar panels does New Caledonia have?

Equipped with more than 58,000 solar panels, the plant has installed capacity of nearly 16 megawatts-peak (MWp), enough to cover the energy needs of over 21,000 residents of New Caledonia. The plant will feature a lithium-ion energy storage system (ESS) with a capacity of nearly 10 MW.

Will TotalEnergies build a 160-MW solar project in New Caledonia?

TotalEnergies will use its expertise in solar projects to build a 160-MW solar project, with the first phase of 30 MW expected to come online by 2023. Once this project is fully operational, it will be sufficient to meet 67% energy needs of Prony Resources New Caledonia and significantly lower carbon emissions.

What is New Caledonia Energy?

New Caledonia Energy is the entity responsible for developing the project for the new power station that will supply the energy for Sociéte Le Nickel (SLN). The current power station is nearly 50 years old and is highly polluting. The ultimate goal is to have a carbon-neutral plant by 2030, which would be a world first in the mining sector.

The earliest sunrise of the month in New Caledonia is 5:18 AM on January 1 and the latest sunrise is 20 minutes later at 5:38 AM on January 31. ... The average daily incident shortwave solar energy in New Caledonia is essentially constant during January, remaining within 0.2 kWh of 7.0 kWh throughout.

In 2022, New Caledonia's electricity consumption was heavily reliant on fossil fuels, making up more than 80% of the total energy mix. Coal was the largest contributor within this category, accounting for about half of the total electricity use. On the other hand, low-carbon or clean energy sources played a smaller role, constituting just under 20% of the electricity consumption.
