Are there Sharks on Norfolk Island?

Common to Norfolk Island is the Galapagos Shark( *Carcharhinus galapagensis* ),also referred to as 'Bronze Whalers'. There appears to be at least 3 other species from this family noted in the Norfolk Island waters,including the Silky Shark ( *C. falciformis* ),the Oceanic White Tip ( *C.longimanus*) and the Blue Shark ( *Prionace glauca* ).

Did historic waste disposal influence tiger shark movements in Norfolk Island?

Whether the historic waste disposal contributed to shaping the movements of Norfolk Island's tiger sharks. Results will be compared between males and females as well as adults and juveniles, with the goal of unravelling the mysteries that drive tiger shark movements in the region.
