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Microgrids generally include generating, storing, and converting energy for distribution to the local community. Using Borrego Springs as an example, the microgrid consists of an array of batteries that can hold

up to 1.5 MW of Direct Current or DC. Microgrids also include technology to convert DC to Alternating Current (AC), which powers a home.

The results show that, utilizing of PV systems for rural electrification in Palestine is economically more feasible than using diesel generators or extension of the high voltage electric grid. The obtained results represents also a helpful reference for energy planers in Palestine and justify the consideration of PV systems more seriously.
