Solar stocks experienced a dramatic selloff on Tuesday, June 17, 2025, as the U.S. Senate's version of President Donald Trump's tax bill maintained provisions to fully phase out renewable energy incentives by 2028. Major solar companies saw double-digit losses in premarket trading, with some stocks plummeting over 27% as investors fled the sector.

Marius Mordal Bakke, a solar supply chain analyst at Rystad, said the largest vertically integrated players will grow market share as smaller players are squeezed out. The top four module manufacturers, Jinko Solar, Trina Solar (688599.SS), Longi and JA Solar, all have integrated cell and wafer supply chains.

It just might not be an obvious reason. In fact, there are five major reasons why a share price may unexpectedly decline. Major institutional shareholders selling large volumes of stock can trigger a significant price drop, but this decline is often temporary, creating potential buying opportunities if the company's fundamentals remain strong.
