The Dutch side power is the same as in the U.S. - 110-125 Volts 60 Hz - and uses the same plugs and sockets as at home. The French side is 220-250 Volts at 60 Hz (yes, 60 and not 50 as in France - this lets the two sides of the island pool their generating capacity).
