Where does the sun shine in Saint Vincent & the Grenadines?

However, the sun shines more often on the coast. Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is an archipelago, made up of no less than 125 islands, most of which are very small. The main islands of the Grenadines are Bequia, Mustique, Canouan, Mayreau, Union Island, Palm Island, and Petit Saint Vincent.

When is the best time to visit Saint Vincent and the Grenadines?

The best time to visit Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is from February to April, since it's the least rainy period of the year, and outside the hurricane season; all in all, even January is an acceptable month, although some additional showers must be put into account.

Does St Vincent get a lot of rain?

Rainfall is abundant, especially on the main island, St Vincent. On this island, we find a volcano, La Soufriere, 1,234 meters (4,049 feet) high, whose slopes are often covered with clouds. However, the sun shines more often on the coast.

In November in St. Vincent and the Grenadines, the average air temperature ranges from 31.0 °C (87.7 °F) during the day to 23.6 °C (74.5 °F) at night. There are 18 days of rain on average, where the rainfall is 260 mm (10.23 in).
