

What is Uzbekistan's Power Energy Strategy?

Generally, the Uzbekistan's power energy strategy and targets for 2030 can be summarized as follows: proceeding with the unbundling and the de-centralization in the industry, including the reforming of the tariff-setting; furthering privatization in the energy sector by the attraction of private foreign and local direct investments;

Who owns power in Uzbekistan?

The majority of Uzbekistan's power generation, transmission and distribution assets are owned and operated by subsidiaries of this state-owned company. Generally, all major generating companies represent separate legal entities owned by JSC Uzbekenergo.

How many kilowatts a thermal power plant produces in Uzbekistan?

In 2018, the power plants of Thermal Power Plants JSC generated 56.3 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity and released 7.5 million Gcal of thermal energy. The total installed capacity of power plants in Uzbekistan is more than 14,000 MW.

Who is responsible for power plants & grids in Uzbekistan?

Thermal Power Plants JSC, Main Electric Networks of Uzbekistan JSC and Regional Electric Networks JSC are jointly responsible for the design, construction, installation and commissioning works in conjunction with the repair and maintenance of the main equipment and accessories of power plants and grids.
