Could a new solar panel roof make Rome a green city?

A new solar panel roof has been inaugurated at the Vatican to provide renewable energy to the museum. It's part of Pope Francis' plans to ensure the city state in Rome runs entirely on green energy. Italian energy supplier ACEA installed the photovoltaic roof in just six months in the Courtyard of the Corazze entrance.

Pope Francis outlined his green vision for the Vatican in his 'Brother Sun' letter in June. In it he said solar panels would be installed on a Vatican-owned property outside Rome and the power generated from that could supply all of Vatican City's energy needs. How will a solar plant benefit the Vatican?

The Pope has given full authority to two special Commissioners to supervise the plant's construction, ensuring that the project is carried out efficiently and effectively. The energy generated by this solar plant will cover all the Vatican's energy needs, eliminating dependence on non-renewable energy sources.

Where is Vatican Radio located?

Located on the edge of Rome, the 424-hectare site houses the transmission facilities for Vatican Radio, thanks to a 1951 agreement between the Holy See and the Italian State. The new plant is intended to supply the energy needs of Vatican Radio and contribute to "the complete energy sustenance of Vatican City State."

Where is Vatican Radio's New solar power plant located?

The plant will be located in Santa Maria di Galeria, some 11 kilometers from Rome, where Vatican Radio's broadcasting station is located. Not only will this project generate renewable electricity, but it will also be integrated with the land's agricultural needs, combining modern technology with sustainable practices.
